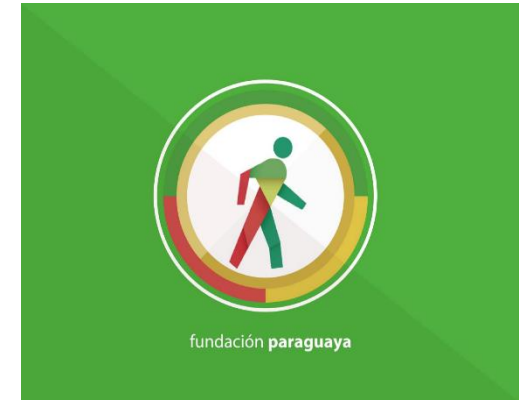

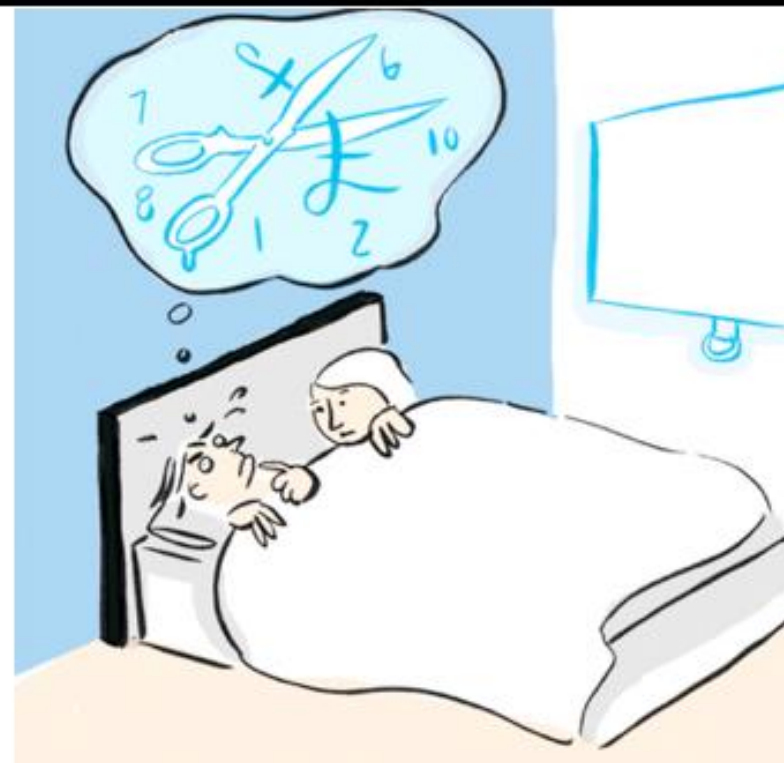
Dimension: Income & Employment

Indicator: Stable Income

Definition: Household income has not varied significantly from one month to the next in the past 6 months. The stability of income is measured because for wellbeing, long term planning and financial resilience, family income should not vary substantially from month to month.



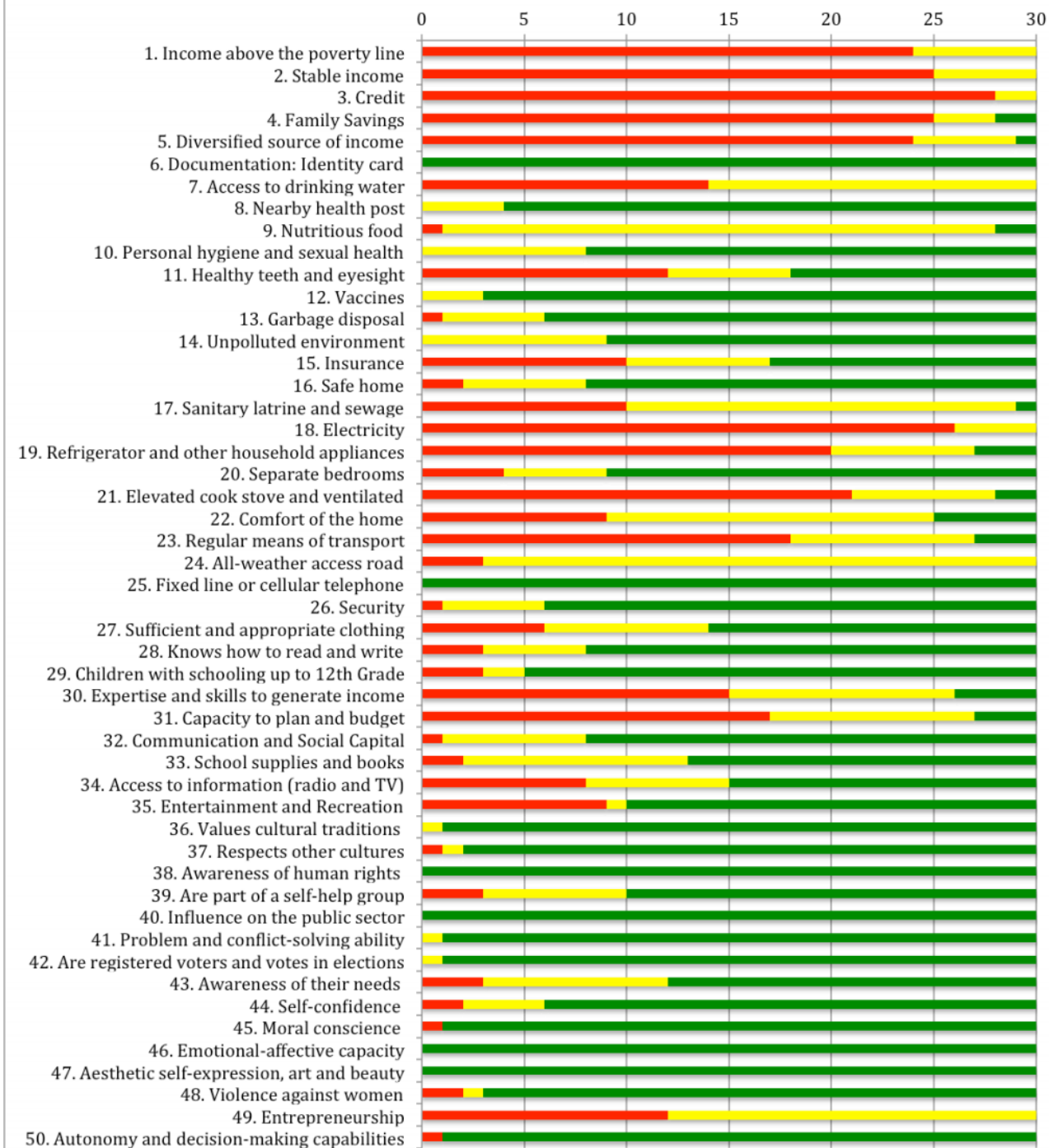
Household income is stable



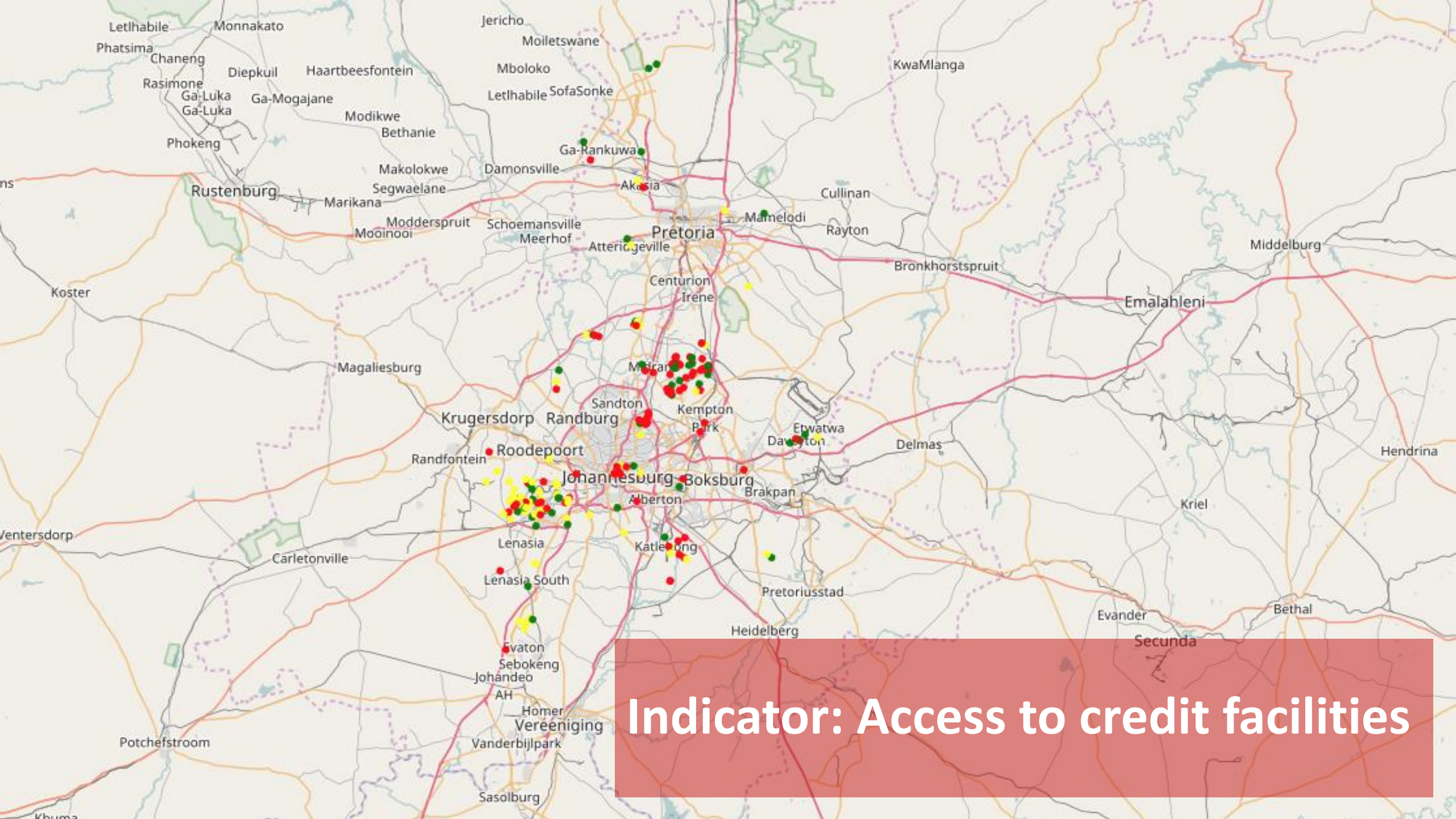
Household income goes up and down a bit



Household income goes up and down a lot making it difficult to plan ahead

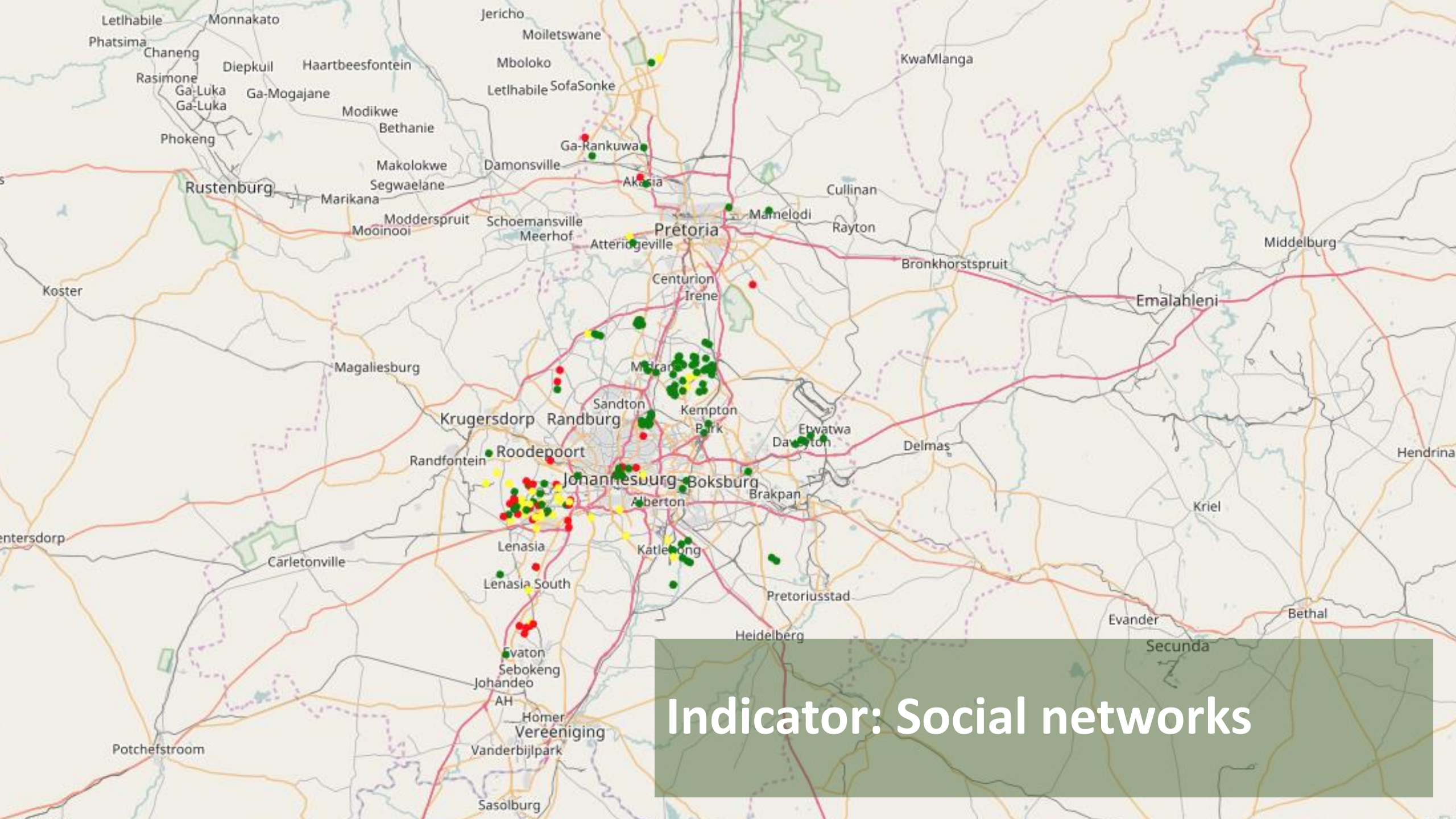






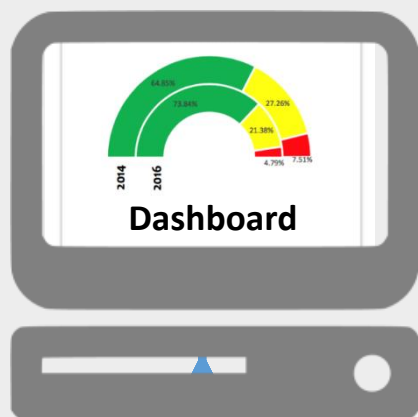
Indicator: Access to credit facilities



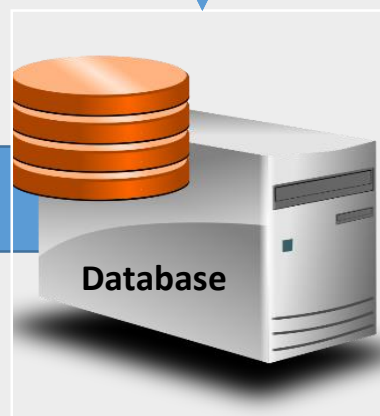


Indicator: Social networks

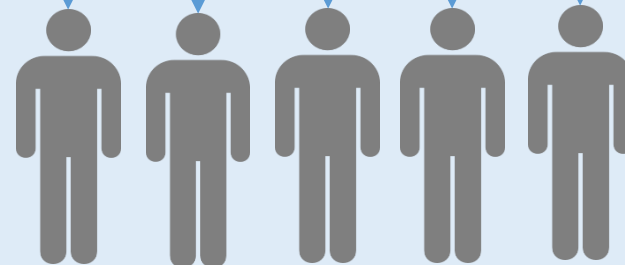
