The Prognostic Impact of Autophagy Biomarkers for Skin Cancer.

Major challenges in melanoma management which include the identification of biomarkers able to identify high risk tumour subsets. Data presented will include the identification of two novel protein biomarkers: AMBRA1 and Loricrin whose expression is retained in the skin (epidermis) overlying genuinely low risk tumours while loss of expression identifies high risk tumour subsets.

The effect of the side chain alkyl length on imidazolium ionic liquid hepatotoxicity

Studies on the presence of xenobiotics in soil samples around a waste site identified the ionic solvent 1octyl-3-methylimidazolium (M8OI) through its toxicity to liver cells. To gain more insight into the toxic effects of M8OI, the effects of different 1-alkyl-3-methylimidazolium ionic solvents were examined in the hepatic progenitor B-13 and hepatocyte like B-13/H cells.
