- To evaluate the effectiveness of VEO in promoting student's reflective learning, including peer feedback and self-reflection.
- To explore ways that students can better understand the assessment process.

Some comments from the self-reflective log

- I notice that if I add a note for a tag, the note will appear a few seconds in advance to signal that: **Hey! Attention!** We have a question or comment for what is going to happen. I think it's pretty good to work in that way. It gives me enough time to get ready for what happens next. I think it will be more useful when the video is getting longer.
- To exploit the **benefit of group wisdom** to an even higher level, we can integrate tagging from all the group members so that the pool will be even bigger
