What is it?


Newcastle University is supporting any colleague involved or interested in **External Examining** to undertake the **Advance HE Professional Development Course**.

The course will lead to a recognition from Advance HE and will consider the role of the External Examiner in the [**UK Quality Code for Higher Education**](#) and develop your ability to use **evidence-informed approaches to contribute to impartial, transparent judgements** on academic standards and enhancing student learning.

Who is it for and why do it?

The course is aimed at **academic and professional service colleagues** who have or are hoping to have a role that includes External Examining either in this institution or in other HEIs in England, Scotland, Wales, Ireland or Internationally.

Not only is it a **professional development course** but on completion it can be used in **evidence for promotion**, and you'll be listed on the Advance HE's **External Examiners Directory website** to make it easier for HEIs to find suitable examiners.
