



North East Law Review: Submission Guidelines

1. All submissions must be word-processed in .doc or .docx compatible format. Submissions must be emailed to submissions.nelr@ncl.ac.uk.
2. The font should be Times New Roman and the font size should be 12.
3. Line spacing should be 1.15 spacing.
4. All submissions must include the Front Page which can be found on the North East Law Review website.
5. Pages must be numbered.
6. Word Limits:
 - a. Longer article submissions should have a minimum of 10,000 words.
 - b. Shorter article submissions should be between 2000 words and 5000 words.
 - c. Case-note submissions should be between 500 words and 1000 words.
 - d. Book Review submissions should be between 1000 words and 3000 words.
 - e. Blog submissions should not exceed 1000 words.
7. All article submissions must include an abstract written and included on the Front Page. Longer articles must have an abstract of 200 words. Shorter articles must have an abstract of 100 words. Case-notes, book reviews and blogs do not require abstracts.
8. All submissions, excluding blogs, must have footnotes (not endnotes) and adhere to the most current edition of OSCOLA at the time of submission. Footnotes should be inserted after any punctuation.
9. Blogs may include hyperlinks to relevant sources mentioned in the body of the blog entry.
10. Hand drawn diagrams and images are strongly discouraged.
11. All work must be original. The North East Law Review reserves the right to check submissions through plagiarism detection software. By submitting your paper, you confirm that it is your own work and that all sources have been acknowledged.
